


When STEP 5 is connectted: Select Input "AV1" of your recorder.






You can copy the contents of a VHS tape to a DVD using the DUBBING button. This allows you to archive your old VHS tapes to DVD.

Preparation: • Set the resolution to 480i using the OUTPUT STATUS button before dubbing.


• Press VCR button to set the VCR mode.





Find the place on the VHS tape from which you want to start dubbing.
